NJSLA - a BRIEF history



- In 2015, NJ adopted the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) to replace HSPA
- In 2019, NJ Student Learning Assessment reconfigured
- NO tests administered - 2020 or 2021
- May 2023
 - ELA grades 3-9
 - Math grades 3-8, Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2
 - Science - grades 5, 8, 11

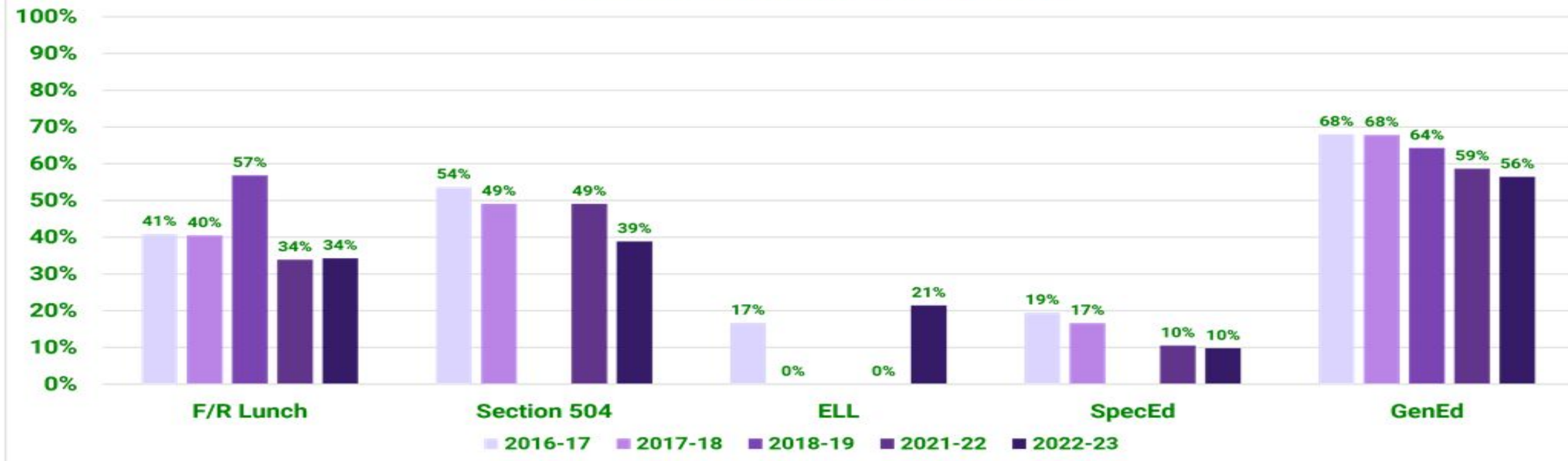

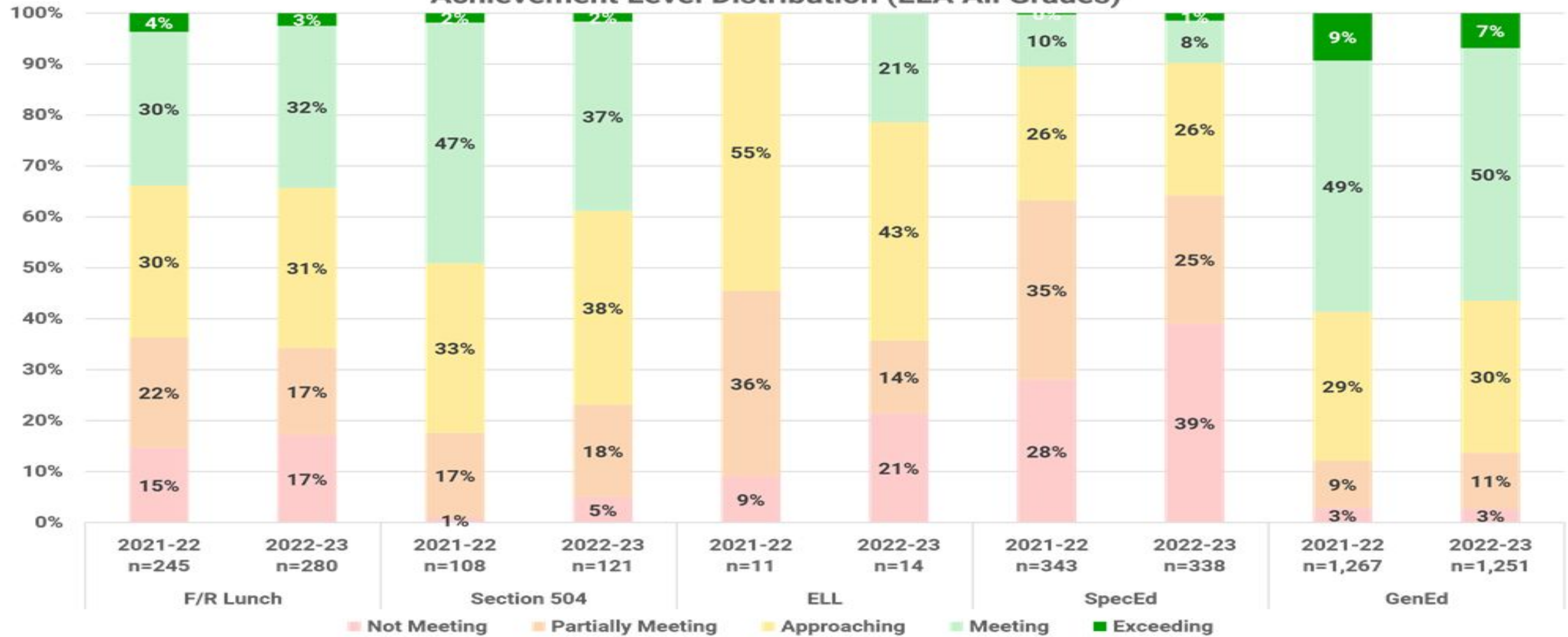

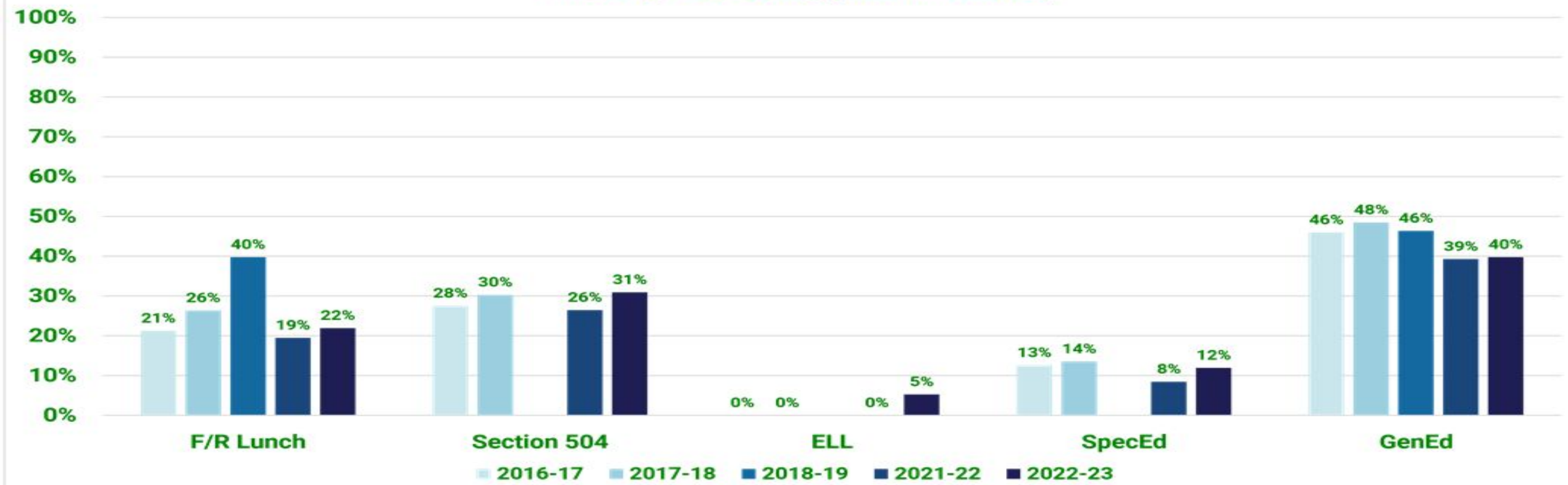
Proficiency by Program

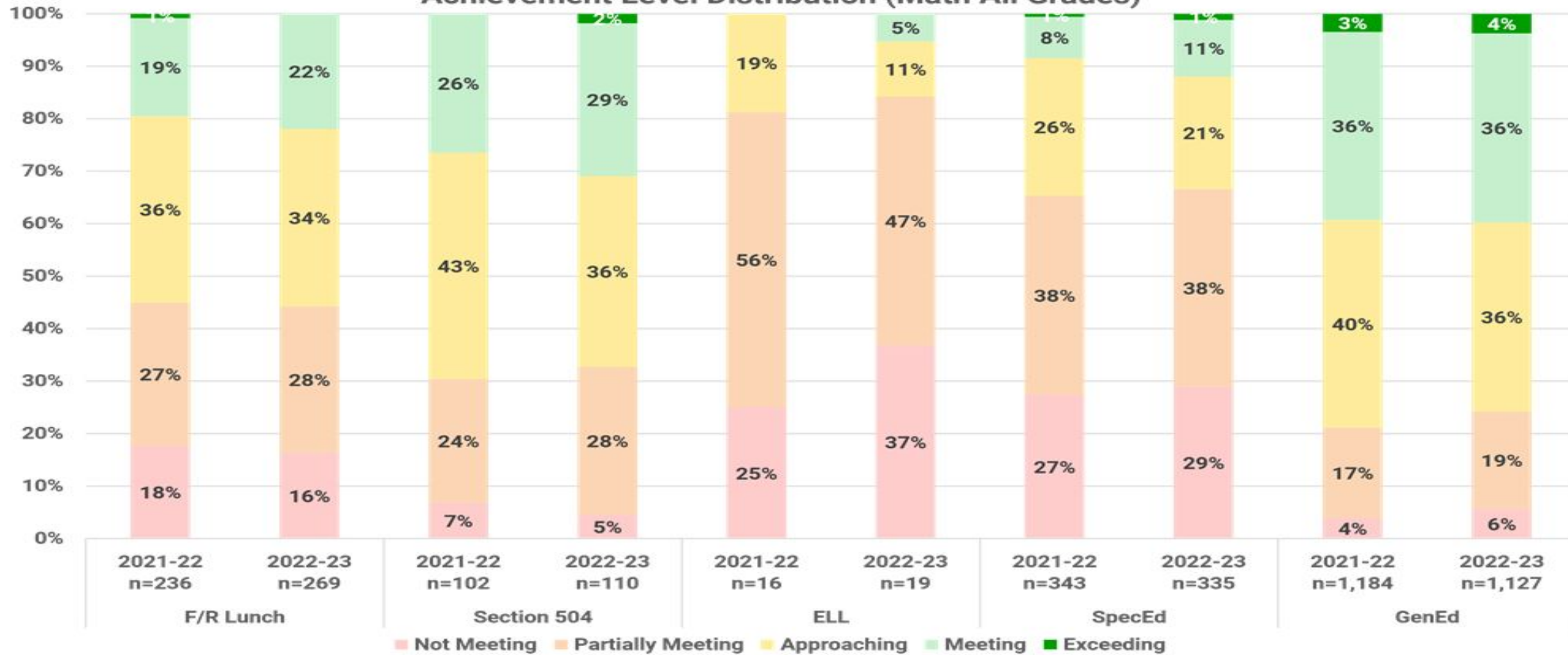
